

Annual Meeting – Sciota Township
March 10, 2008
(draft minutes)

The 2008 annual meeting of Sciota Township was held March 10, 2008 at 6:05 pm at the Township Hall following the budget hearing. Supervisor Matthews called the meeting to order. Members present were Supervisor Matthews, Clerk Koerner, Treasurer Schuman, Trustee Lee and Trustee Thelen. Guests present were Hank Cross, Floyd Koerner, Jr. and Ed Buskirk.

The minutes of the 2007 annual meeting were approved on a motion by Eric Schuman, seconded by Bill Thelen and passed.

There was no treasurer's report. The years totals were listed in the proposed budget.

Public Comment: Norma Lee questioned why the annual meeting wasn't listed on the outdoor sign.

Supervisor's annual report: We must be doing a good job as no one comes to the meetings to complain. The chip seal on Leland and Doyle doesn't look as well as we think it should.

Clerk's report: There are three elections planned for the next year as of now. Nominating petitions for this fall's election are due May 13th. Eric Schuman can notarize them for anyone.

Treasurer's report: Things are going OK. The tax program is working well and makes it much easier to figure what goes to each entity.

Planning Commission: Bill Thelen, chairman, presented their annual report and gave an overview of the year's work. The county still needs a county land division ordinance.

Board of Review: They had about 20 citizens in with questions.

Emergency services report: LSW is out of debt. They are planning to buy a new ambulance. There were 425 fire and rescue and 418 ambulance and medic runs for the 2007 year.
