

## **Annual Meeting - Sciota Township**

**March 8, 2010**

(draft minutes)

The 2010 annual meeting of Sciota Township was called to order by Supervisor Matthews at 6:40 pm following the budget hearing. The Pledge of Allegiance was said by all. Members present were Supervisor Matthews, Clerk Koerner, Treasurer Schuman, Trustee Thelen and Trustee Allen. Guests present were Hank Cross, Floyd Koerner, Jr., David White, Phil Knapp, Norma Lee, Kim Palmer, Laurel Phinney, Ed Buskiirk and Deputy Matt Davis.

Henry Cross moved to approve the minutes of the 2009 annual meeting. Phil Knapp seconded the motion and it passed.

The commissioner was not present.

Public comment: Hank Cross said he appreciated the work the township does. Norma Lee had questions on trailer permits.

Supervisor Matthews gave an update on roads and plans considered.

Clerk Koerner told of coming elections and the possibility of electronic poll books.

Treasurer Schuman told about the number of parcels and delinquencies. He also answered questions.

Sheriff report: Deputy Davis reported that moral is good at the department. They have added a K-9 officer. Video taping as well as voice recording is going to be used when talking to a suspect. He warned everyone to keep keys out of vehicles. Questions were answered.

Planning board: They have reviewed less than a dozen plans this year.

Board of Review: They meet tomorrow and Wednesday. On an average, residential is down 5% and ag is down 2%.

Emergence Services: There were 479 fire and rescue runs and 454 ambulance runs for last year. Of the ambulance, 90 were Sciota Township, 139 for the city and 222 were Woodhull Township. The department is \$265,000 in debt for the new trucks.
