

**Annual Meeting – Sciota Township**  
**March 14, 2011**  
(draft minutes)

The 2011 annual meeting of Sciota Township was called to order by Supervisor Matthews at 6:05 pm following the budget hearing. The Pledge of Allegiance was said by all. Members present were Supervisor Matthews, Clerk Koerner, Treasurer Schuman, Trustee Thelen and Trustee Allen. Guests present were Hank Cross, Floyd Koerner, Jr., Pam Schuman, Mike Reed, Charlene Austin, Ed Buskirk, Norma Lee, Dan Izdebski, Coleen Parker, Matt Tribfelner and David White.

Henry Cross moved to approve the minutes of the March 2010 annual meeting. Floyd Koerner, Jr. seconded it and the motion passed.

Public Comment: Norma Lee asked about the bridge replacements.

Supervisor report: Matthews discussed road work done in the past year and what was coming up for this year. We will be receiving close to \$1,000,000 in government grants for the 2 bridges and the Colby Lake Road intersection. He told of the Board of Review alternates.

Clerk report: Koerner told of using the electronic poll book.

Treasurer's report: Schuman gave yearly report of income, announced that winter taxes have been settled with the county, and that our web site is getting lots of hits.

Planning Commission: Thelen reported there was not much activity this year. They are starting the review of the master plan. There were very few land splits.

Emergency Services: Hank Cross reported 406 ambulance runs in 2010 of which 60 were Sciota Township, 104 city and 241 Woodhull Township. Of 442 fire and rescue runs, 83 were Sciota, 113 city, 127 Woodhull and 4 Bennington. They are installing 2 five hundred gallon tanks for fuel for trucks as were having problems getting what was needed.

Board of Review: Dave White reported they are meeting Tuesday and Thursday of this week. The board does their best to treat everyone fairly.

Old business: None

New business: Hank Cross made a motion to raise the clerk's salary 10% since it has been 7 years since a raise was given. Floyd Koerner seconded it. The motion passed by a 7-4 vote.

Hank Cross made a motion to raise the supervisor salary by 10%. Floyd Koerner seconded it and the motion passed by a 7-4 vote. Nancy Koerner made a motion to raise the treasurer salary by 10%. Mike Reed seconded it. The motion passed by a 7-6 vote.

Hank Cross moved to adjourn the meeting. Mike Reed seconded it and the motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 6:50 pm.
