

Sciota Township Board Meeting – August 8, 2011

(draft minutes)

The September 12, 2011 meeting of the Sciota Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Matthews at 7:00 pm at the Sciota Township Hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was given by all. Members present were Supervisor Matthews, Clerk Koerner, Treasurer Schuman, Trustee Thelen and Trustee Allen. Guests present were Pamela Schuman, Dale Roszman, Hank Cross, Charlene Austin and Ed Kemp.

The minutes of the August meeting were approved on a motion by Thelen and seconded by Allen.

Thelen moved to accept the treasurer's report and place it on file. Koerner seconded the motion and it passed.

Commission report: Dale Roszman reported that the Humane Society will probably be taking over the animal control for the county. She reported on the status of the County Administrator contract.

Public Comment: There was a question on the looks of the floors, followed by others concerns with the hall. It was decided to send a letter to the church with our concerns and also a request to have the checks sent directly to the treasurer.

Board reports: Matthews reported that the grad-all is working in the area. Koerner told of some professional development classes available. None will be attended at this time. She also reported on the Shiawassee County Hazard Mitigation Plan update. Koerner moved to return the letter saying we will participate in the planning process. Matthews seconded it and the motion passed.
